

Voter Registration

In order to actually cast a ballot, you must be eligible to vote *and* registered per MN Statute 201.018. Registration is intended to be easy in Minnesota with the following options provided by MN Statute 201.054:

Subdivision 1. **Registration.** An individual may register to vote:

1. at any time before the 20th day preceding any election as provided in section 201.061, subdivision 1;
2. on the day of an election as provided in section 201.061, subdivision 3; or
3. when submitting an absentee ballot, by enclosing a completed registration application as provided in section 203B.04, subdivision 4.

If you're not registered, you can register online; if you're not sure whether you're registered, you can check your status online.

If you don't vote for four years, your registration is effectively cancelled and you must re-register in order to vote.
